Scholarships ranging from \$500-\$2,000, which can be applied to a variety of educational experiences, will be awarded to Boulder County youth, age 17 through 22, who have demonstrated the ability to thrive through difficult life circumstances.

Boulder County youth, age 12 through 17, will be recognized for their resilience in pursuit of bright and promising futures.

Hero Awards

Professionals who epitomize the values of vision, collaboration and service on behalf of children, youth and families of Boulder County.

~ PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AWARD

One direct youth service provider who exemplifies the principles of professionalism and service in support of our children, youth and families of Boulder County.

~ COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP AWARD

One policy leader who has had a direct impact on the community's ability to best serve in support of our children, youth and families of Boulder County.

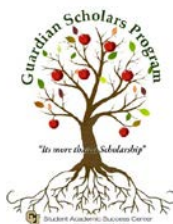

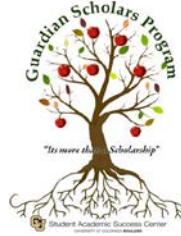

These awards are for a comprehensive funding package toward a four year undergraduate degree at the University of Colorado through a collaborative effort of Realities for Children Boulder County and the University of Colorado Guardian Scholars Program. **Qualified nominees** must be a Boulder County resident or have an open case within a county services system for a minimum of 9 months, have had a history of foster / kinship care after turning 13 years of age, have a minimum 2.8 High School GPA, an ACT of 20 or higher and **must complete the CU admissions process prior to December 15th at 6:00 pm.** RFCBC and CU admissions staff are available to assist the admissions process.
